

The Written Book Report

Your written book report has to be typed on computer. It can, but doesn't need to be in a report folder.

It **must** include:

- Your Name and date. (First and Last name in the top right corner of the paper.)
- The book's title. (Capitalize the important words and center it on the top of the page.)
- The name of the author. (Center it just under the title)
- A paragraph describing the setting of the book. (The setting is where the main part of the story takes place. There may be more than one place in your story to describe.)
- A paragraph describing the characteristic traits of the main character
- A paragraph explaining what happened in the beginning of the book
- A paragraph explaining what happened in the middle of the book
- A paragraph explaining what happened at the end of the book
- A paragraph stating your opinion of the book

The Oral Book Report

An oral book report is one that you will give in front of the class. The following are things you **MUST** do in order to get a passing grade on the book report:

- Tell the book's title.
- Give the name of the author.
- Describe the characteristic traits of the main character(s).
- Describe the setting of the book.
- Explain the problem that the main character(s) had in the story.
- Explain how that problem was solved.
- Give your opinion of the book.
- Memorize your report, or write notes to refer to on 3x5 cards. (Don't read the cards to us. They are only there to help you remember something if you forget. Also, be sure to number your cards just in case they get mixed up. **Standing up in front of the class and reading your report is not an option!**)

- Make eye contact with your audience. (Don't have your eyes glued to your note cards!)
- This book report is due on October 3, 2017. So, let's get started!
